

WHAT IS A RADIOLOGIST?

A radiologist is a physician who specializes in medical imaging. This specialization requires four years of medical residency training and a national board certification exam. Residency training occurs after the physician has completed medical school and a year of medical internship.

HOW WILL MY MEDICAL IMAGING BE TAKEN?

A board-certified radiologist who specializes in the imaging of your particular condition will plan your examination. Based on your symptoms, physical examination findings, lab results, and information from your health care provider, the radiologist will tailor the exam to specifically address your health concern. In some cases the radiologist will give the examination him/herself. At other times, a board-certified radiologic technologist, who is supervised by our radiologists, will conduct the imaging.

WHY DO I NEED MEDICAL IMAGING?

Medical imaging plays an important role in the diagnosis and treatment of illnesses and disease. Your physical examination and lab results are often included with information from medical images when your symptoms are evaluated.

WHO LOOKS AT MY MEDICAL IMAGES?

In all cases, a board-certified radiologist studies images. In fact, most often, a radiologist with fellowship training specific to the imaging study being performed studies the images. For example, a brain MRI image is studied by a fellowship-trained neuro-radiologist. Many times, IMI radiologists collaborate with each other when studying medical images for diagnosis and treatment.

WHAT HAPPENS WITH MY IMAGING RESULTS?

We transmit your examination and results to your provider via a secure, confidential Internet connection. The results of your examination are available to your provider as soon as the radiologist has studied the images and issued the report, typically within hours of your exam being completed and read.

WHY DOES AN ACCREDITED IMAGING FACILITY MATTER?

To achieve the ACR Gold Standard of Accreditation, a facility’s personnel qualifications, equipment requirements, quality assurance, radiation safety, and quality control procedures have gone through a rigorous review process and have met specific qualifications. It’s important for patients to know that every aspect of the ACR accreditation process is overseen by board-certified, expert radiologists and medical physicists in advanced diagnostic imaging.
